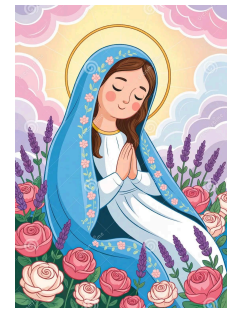
CROWING OF OUR LADY
